## **Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) Program: Annual Mode**

B.Ed. at Mahatma Gandhi T.T. College is a two-year regular teacher training course approved by National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE) and affiliated to University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. The course curriculum intends to professionally Co- Education all the requisite theoretically knowledge and practical skills required by the teachers to handle the challenges posed in the classroom of the new millennium. On the completion of the course, an external exam is conducted by the university annually and the successful candidates are awarded the degree by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

### **Medium of Instruction**

1. The medium of instruction offered for the B.Ed. course are Hindi & English.
2. The medium of Examination is Hindi and English both.

### **Rules for Instruction**

All admission through entrance examination (PTET)

1. It is the responsibility of the candidate to follow the rules the of admission procedure and the instruction imparted, scrupulously.
2. The candidates must remain present at the time of admission and get original certificates.
3. It is the responsibility of the candidate in every respect to see that the information asked in the application form is filled properly and correctly. Permission will not be given any type of change such as category gender etc.
4. The candidates will be required to submit the attested copies of the following documents, Whichever applicable, along-with the application form. Original documents should be brought for verification at the time of admission.

### **Migration Certificate.**

- + B.A./B.Com./B.Sc./B.H.Sc. or any other graduation mark sheet of all years and degree certificate.
- + Mark sheet of secondary & senior secondary.
- + Caste certificate, Domicile Certificate, Non- creamy Layer Certificate (Latest) (OBC, EWS, MBC, etc.)
- + Certificate of physically handicapped.
- + Certificate of active military serviceman or retired military service man /Defense personal.
- + Certificate of Divorcee/Widow.
- + Character certificate from last institute.
- + Affidavit in the given format.

5. The candidate is required to select two subjects as teaching subject which is taught at school level. Teaching subject will be given according to university rules and availability in the college.
6. Ragging is totally banned in the College. Anyone found guilty of ragging and/ or abetting is liable to be punished. The punishment deepening upon the nature gravity of the offence as prescribed under UGC act 1956 as further issued vide their draft notification No.16/2007 (CPP-II) April 2009. All parents/students are required to sign the undertaking at the time of admission as attached with admission form.

**Eligibility Criteria Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)**

**Eligibility for Admission**

There will be a pre-teacher education test called PTET for admission to the B.Ed. College of Rajasthan. PTET organized by an authorized agency (University) nominated by Govt. of Rajasthan. The candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed bachelor's degree and / or master's degree with subjects Science and Mathematics, Social Science/History /Geography/Economics/PoliticalScience/Psychology/Philosophy/Education/Library/Humanity Science (languages and Literature)/ Commerce and secured minimum 50% either in graduation/ post-graduation and those candidates belonging to backward class category (SC, ST & MBC/OBC) who have secured minimum 45% will be considered.

**OR**

The candidate should have obtained any bachelor's degree given by Open University incorporated by act of the central or State Legislature or according to the instructions of PTET Convener.

**OR**

The candidate who has appeared for the final year examination of any bachelor's degree awarded by any of the universities incorporated by an act of the Central or State Legislature or declared to be Deemed University under section 3 of the UGC ACT 1956.

- Candidates who are appearing for the qualifying examination in the academic year 2024-25 are also eligible to apply for PTET subject to the condition that their result up to the last date of online counselling registration and have marksheet of the qualifying examination with eligibility percentage.
- In case the candidates are awarded Grades/CGPA instead of marks, the conversion of Grades, CGPA to percentage of marks would be based on the formula /procedure certified by the Board/University/Institution from where the candidate has obtained the bachelor's degree. The candidate will have to bring the necessary proof to that effect from the Board/University/Institution.

- The candidate belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/(Woman) categories should produce “Caste Certificate” issued by the Competent Authority. All the (OBC/MBC/EWS) category Candidate should submit Valid Non-Creamy Layer certificate at the time of verification of documents/ Admission/Reported to the allotted College.


